

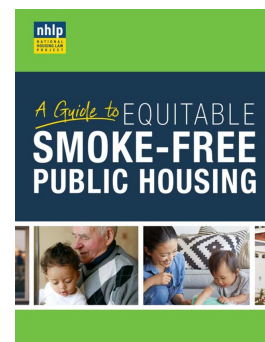

Upcoming Webinar: Equitable Smoke-Free Policies in Public Housing

Our friends at the National Housing Law Project (NHLP) just released *A Guide to Equitable Smoke-Free Public Housing*. This [guide](#) is a resource for Public Housing Authorities, tenants, and advocates who are seeking to find the proper balance between two important public health issues-- promoting smoke-free environments and ensuring access to affordable, stable housing. While the guide focuses on HUD's Public Housing smoke-free rule, the philosophy of equitable implementation and enforcement can be applied to all types of rental housing.
