### A Training for People Who Work in Public Housing

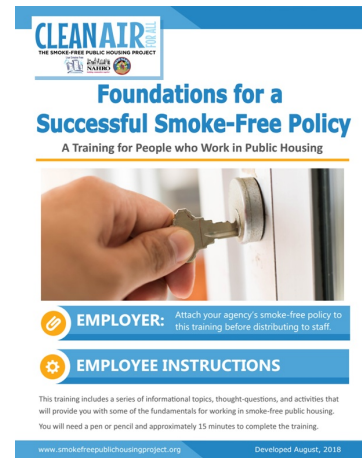
